DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO ACCEPT OR REJECT THE BID FOR THE NORHT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT REPAIRS/UPGRADES AND MUSTANG PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT

After discussion, a motion was made Ed Reed and seconded by James Pate to accept the bid from Associated Construction Partners, Ltd. in the amount of \$5,868,300.00 for the North Wastewater Treatment Plant and Mustang Pump Station generator buildings. The motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO PURCHASE (6) PORTABLE GENERATORS AS A FEMA REIMBURSABLE **PROJECT**

After discussion, a motion was made by Walter Sohl and seconded by Ed Reed to purchase six portable generators through the Houston-Galveston Area Council co-operative purchasing program for the sum of \$402,624.00 with 80% of the costs being paid through a FEMA Grant. The motion carried unanimously.
