<u>DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR NEW MOBILE EMERGENCY GENERATORS-FEMA PROJECT NO: DR-4322-02397</u>

5. After discussion, a motion was made by Walter Sohl and seconded by Ed Reed to award the contract to Scott Electric for the amount of \$1,542,207.00. This motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO GRANT AUTHORITY TO THE DISTRICT MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE WITH THE CITY OF PORT ARANSAS FOR LEONABELLE TURNBULL BIRDING CENTER EXPANSION AND AMENITIES, BY EXTENDING THE EXISTING LEASE FOR A PORTION LOT 5, BLOCK 148 FOR (30) THIRTY YEARS AND INCLUDING THE ADDITION OF LOTS 4A AND 4B, BLOCK 148 IN THE SAME AGREEMENT

- 6. After discussion, Director Ed Reed made the following motions
 - A. I move to grant authority of the District Manager to enter into a lease with the City of Port Aransas for Leonabelle Trunbull Birding Center Expansion and amenities, by extending the existing lease for a portion of Lot 5, Block 148 for thirty years.
 - B. I move to amend the lease to include the addition of Lots 4A and 4B, Block 148 in the same agreement. Seconded by Josh Garcia, the motions carried unanimously.
